

GLOBAL FILM & TIME CODE CONVERTER

1
Green cells in the **MAIN AREA** allow the user to choose film and/or video formats to convert to and from.

2
Input a start footage or time code. Separators such as colons or semi-colons are not allowed. Plus (+) and minus (-) signs are treated as addition or subtraction indicators.

3
OFFSETS are useful if you need to add or subtract the same value to a series of time codes or footages.

4
Values below the "CONVERT TO" selection box are converted results of the original value (2) plus or minus the offset (3).

Additional OFFSETs can be entered into the second last column. Remember that separators are not allowed.

The last column shows the result of adding and subtracting any offsets i.e. (3) & (5) to the original value (2).

Additional conversions can be entered in the **LOWER SECTION**. Values and offsets from the main area are automatically reflected in this lower section but you may enter other values as needed.

TIPS & TRICKS:

- 1 Use the SHEET TABS at the bottom of the spreadsheet to select the type of conversion
- 2 Numbers in the LOWER SECTION are defaulted to reflect entries in the MAIN AREA. If you enter new values into the lower section and then find that you need to use the GLOBAL OFFSETs then just download the link again to reset the worksheet.
